Dear Children's Treatment Centre families,

On Thursday, July 29<sup>th</sup> from 4-6pm, the CK Vaccination Team is offering a Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccination clinic at Children's Treatment Center of Chatham-Kent (CTC-CK). The clinic is for clients who are 12-17 years of age and youth 18-21 who are in school. This clinic is open to clients who would like either a 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> dose. We're also inviting siblings of CTC-CK clients 12-17 years of age for 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> dose.

**Please note that 2<sup>nd</sup> doses must be at least 28 days after the 1<sup>st</sup>.**

**Booking an Appointment:**

If you are interested in having your child vaccinated at the CTC-CK clinic, please contact the CTC-CK at 519-354-0520 ext 0.

If this clinic date does not work for you, youth 12-17 looking for a 1<sup>st</sup> dose can also walk-in at Bradley during any Pfizer-BioNTech clinic. Youth 12-17 and family members who are in need of a 2<sup>nd</sup> dose can book appointments at any one of our Pfizer-BioNTech vaccination clinics online [getyourshotck.ca](http://getyourshotck.ca) or by calling 519-351-1010. If you anticipate needing any assistance while at the clinic, please let us know when booking.

Youth should wear a short sleeve shirt. Appointments should take about 30 minutes.
