I can take a break if I need to.



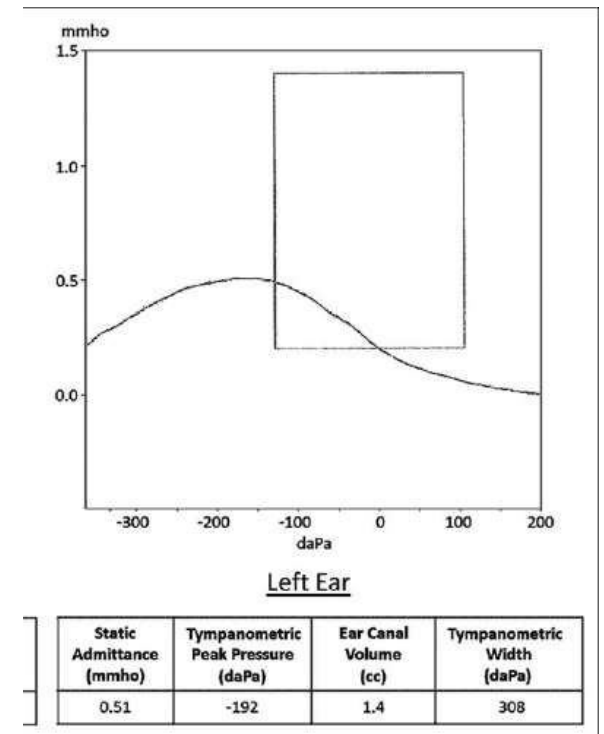
She will look in my ears with a pointy flashlight. It is called an otoscope. She will put it into both of my ears to see. She will be gentle. I can take a break if I need one.
