## OVERVIEW

The Job Jedi Masters Program is an introductory paid employment program offered to youth aged 15-18 [21 if still in school], who are clients of the CTC-CK. This program will provide hands on learning, and support development of skills that can be added to their resume.



## WHAT DOES A JJM DO?

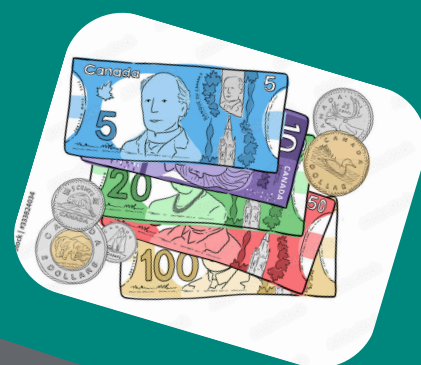
During their shift, the youth receive support from a job coach while completing a variety of tasks at the Children's Treatment Centre. Some tasks that the JJMs are responsible for completing include: gardening, laundry, administrative work, running our JJM Java Kart, and other custodial work such as cleaning, mopping, and vacuuming.
