BUS SERVICES

RideCK

Chatham-Kent's bus system and offers pickup every 30 minutes. Urban transit is available throughout the city of Chatham, and inter-urban transit links our many communities together, providing service throughout the municipality.

Conventional Transit Accessibility

Ride CK's conventional buses are all fully accessible low-floor vehicles with automatic ramps, space to secure personal mobility devices, and next bus stop announcement systems for those with visual and hearing disabilities.

RideCK Inter-Urban Routes

Inter-Urban public transit connects our Chatham-Kent communities.

OnRequest Transit

Ride CK OnRequest Transit provides seven days a week shared ride public transit trips between any two designated bus stop locations within an urban area. Unlike traditional fixed-route service, OnRequest requires riders to request a trip through a mobile app, web portal or by calling. The bus will pick you up at your closest bus stop and drop you off at the bus stop closest to your destination while picking up other riders along the way.

Specialized Transit

Ride CK offers Specialized Transit in Chatham and Wallaceburg for individuals whose disability cannot be accommodated on conventional transit. The service provides pre-booked, curb-to-curb shared rides within urban boundaries. Eligibility may be permanent, temporary, or conditional, and applications are accepted year-round through the Municipality of Chatham-Kent. 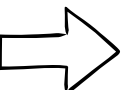
Uride is a ridesharing service which users access online or through the app.

CareLink Health Transit - Accessible

CareLink offers timely and affordable non-urgent health transportation services in Chatham-Kent. Eligible passengers are adults 18+ years of age with a disability, or adults age 60+, travelling for a medical appointment. CareLink vehicles are fully accessible and can accommodate up to 5 passengers at a time including 2 passengers using wheelchairs. Passengers requiring assistance can be accompanied by a caregiver, free of charge. Fares are based on the destination and lengthier drives may include additional costs.
